

Sub: Terms and Conditions for Candidates Seeking Admission to Private BTC Reg.

Following Terms and Conditions shall be applicable for the Candidates seeking admission to Private Basic Training Course (BTC) conducted by AAI Fire Training Establishments;

1. **Application fee:** A non-refundable amount of Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Fifty Only) per application as application fee towards administrative charges for scrutiny of documents and selection process.
2. **Refund of course fee:**
 - 2.1. In case the candidate opts to discontinue the course on medical grounds, i.e. the candidate is declared unfit by RMP/MBBS doctor, within 8 weeks of commencement of training then refund of 50% of the course fee shall be applicable. Refund includes 50% of tuition fee and canteen charges in case of discontinuation of course on medical grounds. No refund shall be applicable on discontinuation after 8 weeks till completion of course. GST charges will not be refunded.
 - 2.2. No refund of course fee is applicable in case of expulsion of a candidate at any stage of the course on disciplinary grounds by Fire Training Establishments.
 - 2.3. Any false information furnished by the candidate in the application shall make him/her liable for summary dismissal from the course at any stage and course fee shall be forfeited.
3. **Medical treatment of candidates during course period:** The candidates shall have a suitable medical insurance policy for medical treatment to meet out any health emergency/ sickness during the period of training. Candidates shall submit documents in this regard at the time of admission.
4. **Other terms and conditions:**
 - 4.1. Incomplete applications will not be entertained and no further communication will be made in this regard.
 - 4.2. AAI Fire Training Establishments reserve the right to accept or reject any of the applications for admission.
 - 4.3. The training involves considerable amount of physical training and activities. AAI Fire Training Establishments shall not be responsible for any injury/ accident sustained during the course of Training. Candidates shall execute an indemnity bond as per the format of the institution to this effect.
 - 4.4. The course is strictly residential and outside stay shall not be permitted.
 - 4.5. On admission, the candidate shall abide by the rules, regulations and code of conduct of the AAI Fire Training Establishments.
 - 4.6. The purpose of this training is to impart skills and knowledge required for ARFF services. AAI Fire Training Establishments do not take any responsibility for job guarantee after the training.
 - 4.7. Applicant is solely responsible for submitting the factual data about the candidature. AAI Fire Training Establishments shall not be liable for any misinformation furnished by the candidate during admission, in any form.
